2012 REBATES* LIMITED BUDGET; FIRST-COME, FIRST-SERVED.

As part of our ongoing effort to incentivize water conservation, we respectfully ask all homeowners, neighborhoods and businesses we serve to participate in our 2012 Water Conservation Equipment & Appliance Rebate Program. Please review the following menu of water-saving rebate options and decide how you can best conserve water this season.

Equipment & Appliance	Water Conservation Benefit	Rebate Amount
Rotator Sprinkler Nozzles	Water-efficient nozzles deliver streams of water that reduce evaporation loss.	Up to \$5/nozzle; replacement only. Limit 20 nozzles/household or 200 nozzles/HOA or Commercial.
Rain Sensors	Detects rainfall and overrides irrigation system.	\$100 (Limit one per household)
Programmable Irrigation Clock	Implements 3-day watering rotation by time of day.	\$75 (Limit one per household)
Evapotranspiration Controller (Residential)	Regulates irrigation based on temperature, rainfall and humidity.	\$200 (Limit one per household)
Evapotranspiration Controller (HOA/Commercial)	Regulates irrigation based on temperature, rainfall and humidity.	Varies with size of system, up to 50% of purchase price. Metro District must first review & approve plan.
Sod Replacement (Residential)	Replace sod with WaterWise Plants (Xeriscaping).	\$0.40/sq. ft. (500 sq. ft minimum. 4,000 sq. ft. maximum.) Metro District must first review & approve plan.
Sod Replacement (HOA/Commercial)	Replace sod with WaterWise Plants (Xeriscaping).	\$0.40/sq. ft. (500 sq. ft minimum. No maximum limit.) Metro District must first review & approve plan.
Low Flow Toilets	Uses 1.6 gallons. Old toilets use 3-5 gallons.	\$100 / toilet. Limit 3 per household; replacements only.
Front Loading or Low Water Use Washing Machines	Uses 27 gallons versus 40-45 gallons per load.	\$125 / machine (Limit two per household)
Water Efficient Showerhead	Uses 2.4 gallons / minute versus 4 gallons / minute.	\$10/showerhead. Limit 4 per household; replacements only.

* All rebate requests must be accompanied by the 1-page **Rebate Request Form** (available at www.cpnmd.org), a copy of the applicable sales receipt and a picture of the installed item. The Metro District will credit rebates to your water bill. In no case may the rebate amount exceed the purchase price. Please contact the Metropolitan District at 303-688-8550 with questions.
