## Accepting Applications for New Board-Vacancy Appointment

During its regular board meeting on Tuesday, January 22, 2019, Castle Pines North Metro District President David McEntire announced that Norman Froman, for personal reasons, has resigned from the metro district board of directors.

Applicants should be prepared to serve out the remainder of Norman Froman's two-year term on the board – until May of 2020 — and should plan to participate in 1-2 monthly board meetings, each of which typically spans 2-4 hours. Board meetings usually occur on the third Monday of each month and begin at 6:00 p.m.

Directors often commit 7-12 hours per week to the position.

The board intends to fill the vacancy during its next regular meeting at 6:00 p.m., on Tuesday, February 19, 2019, at the Castle Pines Community Center, located at 7404 Yorkshire Drive, Castle Pines, 80108.
