We recently posted a user-friendly calculator that enables each CPNMD residential customer to understand how the proposed Inclusion (merger) of our water and wastewater utilities with those of the Parker Water & Sanitation District would impact their respective monthly bills.

Click on the joint PWSD/CPNMD logo at cpnmd.org and check it out!

To use the calculator, CPNMD's residential customers need to enter only two figures into the designated fields. Our conscientious customer service representatives Susan and Carol, and our billing manager, Dawne, are standing by at (303) 688-8550 to provide you the two figures you will need to plug into the monthly bill calculator.

- First, enter your **Total Monthly Water Consumption** (in gallons) in the first designated field.
- Second, enter your **2021 Wastewater (Sewer) Winter Average Factor** (your average monthly winter use in gallons) in the second field.

Assuming you enter the two figures correctly, the calculator will automatically compute your **Total Estimated Monthly Bill** for water & sewer services as it otherwise would have been last year under PWSD's rate structure.

- 2) Ballots will be mailed out to all legally registered CPNMD voters the week of Monday, April 12, 2021.
- 3) Ballots must be returned via U.S. mail or hand-delivery to one of two ballot drop-box locations:

- 5) Ballots received after 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 4, 2021, will not count.
- 6) UOCAVA (overseas and military) voters have until Wednesday, May 12, 2021, to return their ballots.

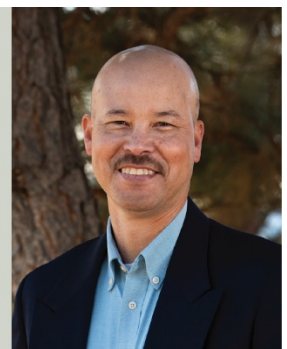
